Currently interest catechists must travel to other parishes or attend workshops in small multipurpose rooms with little or no educational resources. Fr. Zambo plans to build a small classroom and stock a few library shelves with appropriate books and resources to help develop and form his community's leaders. A gift of \$20 helps purchase materials. A gift of \$100 dollars helps start construction.
