NEWS AND IMPORTANT DATES

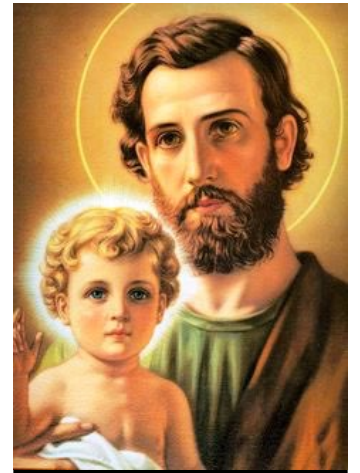
