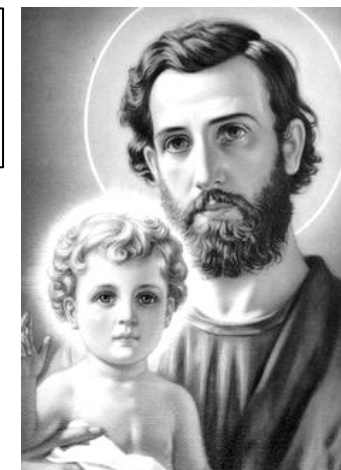

Expense: -\$87,682.09.
